6	Written consent from official sponsor to enter or remain in the United Kingdom under the International Graduates Scheme if his approved studies, or any studies he has subsequently undertaken, were sponsored by a government or international scholarship agency	
7	If you are paying for your trip, you will need to provide proof of your ability to maintain and accommodate yourself and dependants e.g. bank book or bank statement with a copy showing at least 6 months any transactions	
8	Undertaking statement intention to leave the United Kingdom if, on expiry of his leave under this scheme	
9	A certificate issued by International Organisation for Migration (IOM) confirming that the applicant is free from infectious tuberculosis (TB) Applies to all applicants aged 11 years and over (if you have been back to Thailand for more than six months)
